Sylvia came in to consult with us about the Creative Schools initiative. We can't wait to see what happens next!

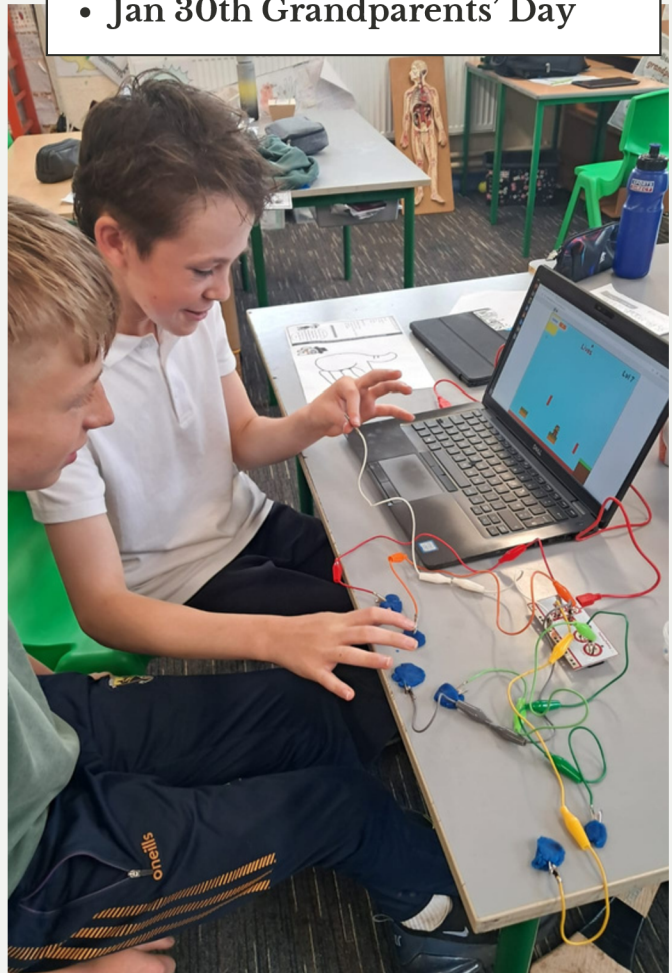
Our Craft Fair and Tractor Run was a huge success, as was our Carol Singing and Christmas Line Draw. Thanks to everyone who supports our school.

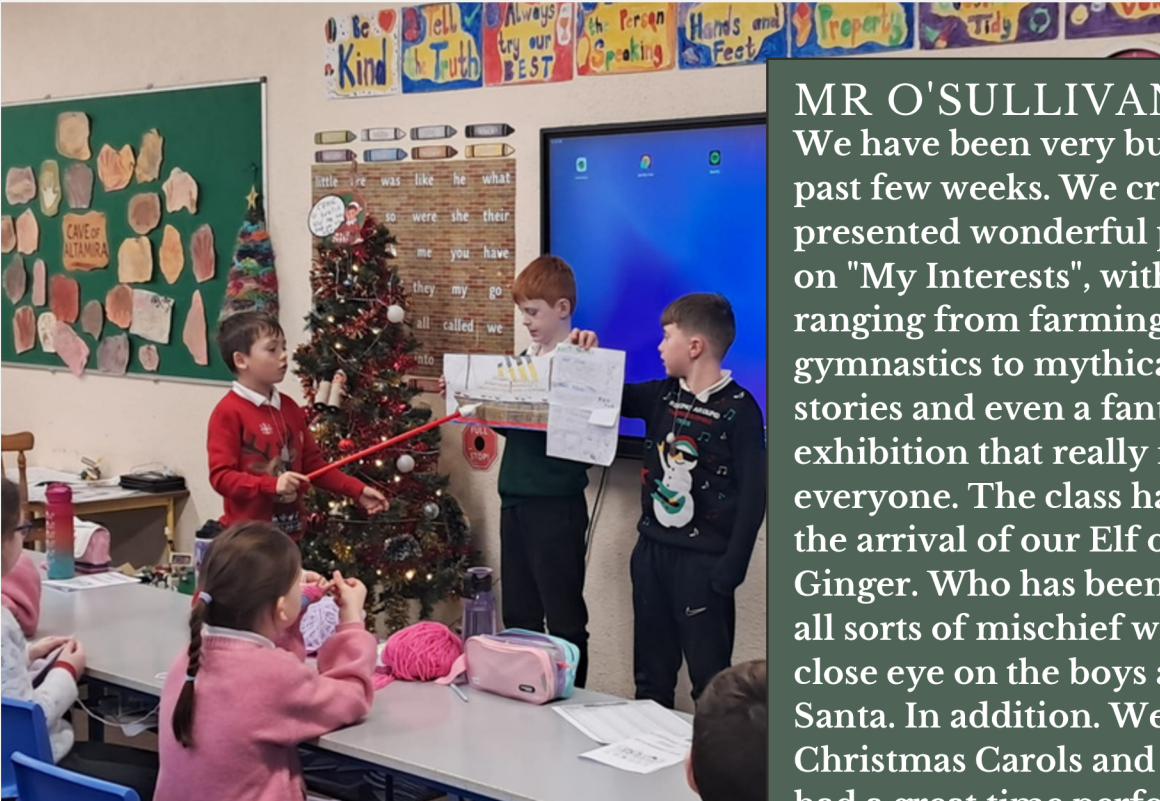


MS ROCHFORD'S CLASS
